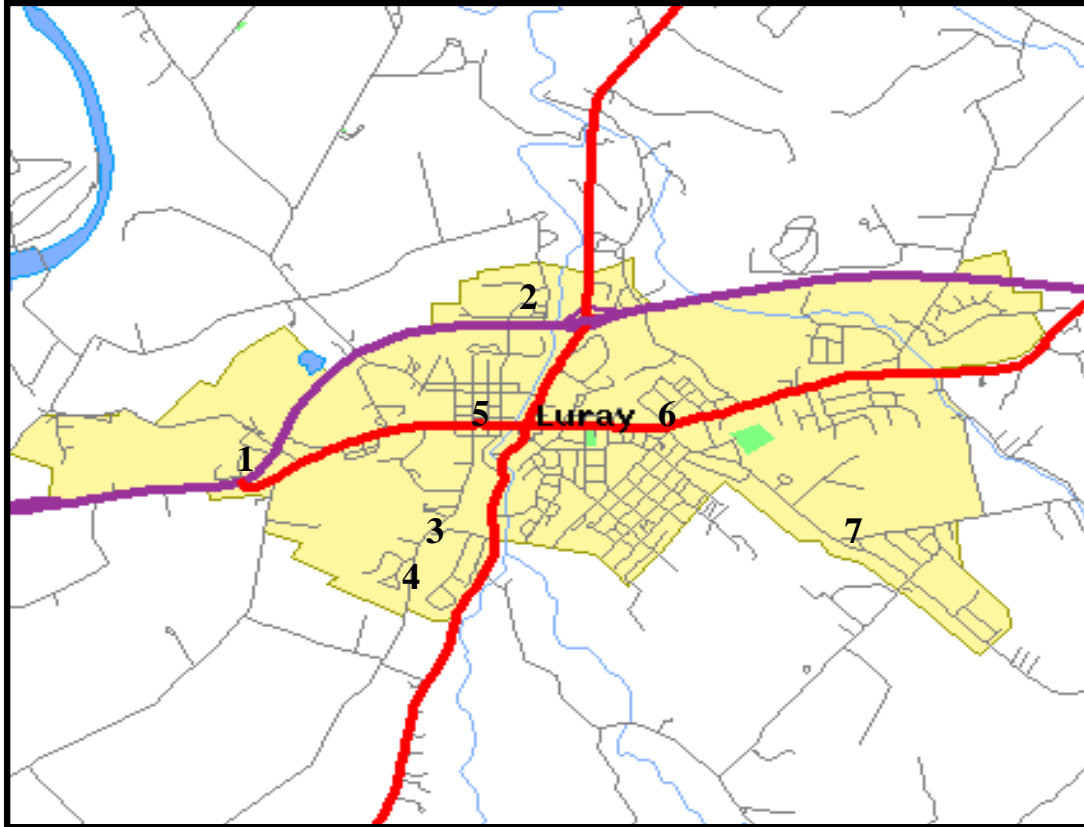


Traffic Problem Areas In Need of Improvement



1. **Northcott Drive and U.S. Route 211:** Numerous accidents have taken place at this intersection. Presently this intersection has blinking caution lights. Improvements needed for this intersection could potentially include a signal and a right turn lane onto Northcott Drive.

2. **North Hawksbill Street/Cottage Drive and U.S. Route 211:** A small dip in the west bound portion of U.S. 211 makes it difficult for drivers on Cottage Drive to see cars that might be in the dip due to high speeds.

3. **South Court Street and Mill Creek Road:** The atypical geometry of this intersection makes is somewhat confusing. It is believed that improving the geometry of this intersection in order to make a four-way intersection would be appropriate.

4. **Mill Creek Road and Forest Hills Drive:** Forest Hills Drive intersects Mill Creek Road at an undesirable angle. This intersection should be improved so that Forest Hills Road connects with Mill Creek Road at or near a 90 degree angle.

5. **Court Street and Main Street:** Sight distance for drives on Court Street trying to cross or enter Main Street buildings and parked cars. A signal would improve this intersection.

6. **Brumback Avenue and Reservoir Avenue:** Presently the intersection of Brumback Avenue and Reservoir Avenue (at East Main Street) is offset. Aligning Brumback Avenue and Reservoir Avenue would significantly improve the safety of this intersection for traffic traveling north on Reservoir to Brumback, and it would allow for Brumback Avenue to be converted back to a safe “two way” Street.

7. **Eden Road and Fairview Road:** For traffic turning north (from Eden Road) sight distance to the south (on Fairview Road) is very poor. Eden Road should be realigned in order to give an equal amount of sight distance once at the intersection of Fairview Road.
