Turn right onto Brookstone Road, go 1/10 mile, turn left onto Valley Burg Road. Go 1.3 miles to the Lake Arrowhead entrance on the left. (Note: Valley Burg Road will turn to the right prior to the Lake entrance – keep going straight on Lake Arrowhead Road.)

Look for brown signs along route.

Lake Arrowhead Park is a 134-acre recreation area located 3 miles outside the Luray town limits. Built in the early 1970's, the park has a 34-acre lake with fishing, boating, and a white sand beach for swimming. Six picnic shelters, a playground area, and a handicapped accessible boat dock and restrooms help make Lake Arrowhead an ideal place for visitors of all ages and abilities.
